Director of Children's Music

Job Description

Working in collaboration with the Director of Worship and Music, the Director of Children's Music will carry out the following functions:

- Revive and direct a children's choir
- Lead annual Children's Christmas Program (seasonal evening and/or Sunday morning rehearsals)
- Lead annual summer Musical Theatre production (one (1) week intensive camp)
- Assist the Director of Children and Family Ministries with music activities for annual Vacation Bible School (VBS) (one (1) week)
- Liaise with parents of young children to recruit for all of the children's music programs
- Recruit youth to revitalize youth involvement in worship music

Other duties:

- Serve as accompanist for adult choir (negotiable, depending on skill set)
- Assist Director of Worship and Music in other music program-related tasks.

Time onsite

During a regular week, the Director of Children's Music would be needed onsite for one (1) evening rehearsal, two (2) Sunday services, and a rehearsal between services. There may also be periodic meetings in the evenings and/or on Sundays (morning/early afternoon). *Please note*: This schedule and job description is only to serve as an example and could change depending on needs of the church and the skills of the Director of Children's Music.

Required qualifications: Undergraduate degree in music (or 3–5 years' experience leading a children's choir)

Preferred qualifications: Undergraduate degree in music education; advanced keyboard skills (able to sightread or quickly learn accompaniments and choral parts, ability to read open score); experience conducting; Spanish proficiency.
